In December Epilogue Bookstore took in \$1,020.00. December's end of the month sales report documented that a total of 476 items were sold; the best selling item was hard back books. Thank you volunteers for making all this possible.

The main entrance for the bookstore will still be accessed via the current key kept in the cash box.
